Jenkintown, PA – On Saturday, March 31st, the Ukrainian Educational and Cultural Center will open its doors at 9:00 am to greet its many guests to the sights, sounds, and yes, delicious aromas of Ukraine at the Annual UECC Easter Bazaar.

The bazaar will be open until 6:00 pm. There is no admission charged, but plenty of vendors to visit. Many vendors, from near and far, will be offering the Philadelphia area community the best of their wares: colorful Ukrainian Easter Eggs – Pysanky, beautiful embroideries, delicate crafts, Trypillian and Hutzul ceramics, cards, books, oil paintings, intricate jewelry, religious icons, Ukrainian music – tapes, cds, and videos and much, much more!

A Pysanka (Ukrainian Easter Egg) Decorating Workshop will be held as well during the Easter Bazaar. Adults and children will have the opportunity to make pysanky - Ukrainian Easter Eggs. Skilled instructors will teach the art of making pysanky in two sessions. The first will be from 10:00 am to 12:00 pm. The second session will last from 1:00 pm to 3:00 pm. Learn about dyes, instruments, and traditional Ukrainian designs and motifs. Fee per session: Adults - \$10, Children (aged 6 and up) - \$10. Eggs, dyes, beeswax, and a stylus are included in the workshop fee. Please register for the workshops by calling the UECC Office at 215-663-1166. Also specify which workshop you would like to attend. Please note: Adult with children is free.

No bazaar is complete without the traditional Ukrainian kitchen and bakery. Food will be served for eating in and taking out.
